MULTI FUNCTIONAL VET CENTER (MFC) OF KAMZA

The National Strategy for Employment and Skills 2014 - 2020, has reinforced the goal to offer quality vocational education and training to youth and adults. In this context the MFC in Kamza is a new model of VET provider, combining several elements of the dual system like full-time and part-time vocational education with emphasis to practical training in private companies that will make students better prepared for the labour market.

The MFC also offers short term vocational training courses tailor-made to a wide range of target groups and ages including students, unemployed job seekers, disadvantaged groups, and technical trainings according to special requests from business.

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WHY CHOOSING THE MFC KAMZA?

The MFC offers a variety of profiles demanded in the local and national labour market. Learning takes place in a new building with selected well-equipped laboratories and qualified teaching staff. The training curricula are updated to improve the combination between theory and practice towards more professional practice conducted in the laboratories at school or via internships at the business place. You have the opportunity to participate in different extra-curricular activities organized by the school directorate and teaching staff in collaboration with business such as, Job fairs, Open Days, Girl's Day, Skills Competitions etc.

If you have excellent results there might even be an opportunity to benefit from exchange visits with other VET schools in Albania or abroad and learning opportunities offered in the framework of cooperation agreements signed by the MFC with business and EU funded projects.

1. New and modern MFC building, very well equipped ICT, Electronic, Social and Health care laboratories made available by the GIZ VET Programme with funding from the German Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).

2. Exchange with the OSZ-IMT ICT School in Berlin. An agreement between the two schools was signed in May 2015. The first visit of German students to the MFC Kamza is planned to take place in November 2015.



3. The MFC Kamza is part of the Erasmus+ project "Apprenticeships for Youth Employability in Albania" implemented in 2015 and 2016. The project is led by the Albanian VET Agency NAVETQ in partnership with the Hamburg Institute for Vocational Education and Training in Germany. The project provides the frame for testing the dual approach in the hotel/tourism sector in cooperation with hotels and restaurants in Tirana and surroundings.



4. Skills Competitions. Every year the MFC Kamza, together with VET schools from all over the country participates in the Skills Olympiad organized by MEGATEK. In the competition of 2014 and 2015 MFC Kamza got respectively the third and the first prize.



5. Open Days aim to expose the VET offer to the pupils of the 9-year primary schools located in Kamza and its surroundings; to promote competences and skills attained by students at the MFC Kamza to local businesses thus increasing the opportunities for employment; to strengthen links between school, local community and vulnerable groups of society etc.



6. The Girl's Day aims to encourage young student girls to attend the VET schools and in particular attract them in profiles considered traditionally as a male domain. Other information on gender issues, such as women economic empowerment and domestic violence are provided in order to increase their awareness and social inclusion.



7. Cooperation Agreements with Business Associations offering opportunities for structured traineeships in a real work environment to young students from the MFC Kamza; Agreements are signed with BiznesAlbania, Gentlemen's house, Porsche and Volkswagen Company, Hotel Mondial etc.



8. Since 2013 every year the MFC Kamza participates in the Job Fair organized by the MSWY. The main purpose is to promote VET in general and expose the MFC Kamza students to the businesses which participate or visit the event.



Success stories of former Students of the Kamza MFC




